When your child enters kindergarten this fall, he/she will experience many new adventures. To help children make safe and positive choices, the Greater Port Washington Kiwanis Club, in conjunction with the Port Washington and Saukville Police and Fire Departments, will be offering the <u>Safety Town</u> Program to all children who will be entering kindergarten in the **fall of 2018**.

<u>Safety Town</u> is a nationally recognized program, which teaches young school aged children a variety of safety issues. Some of the safety issues the children will be learning are:

Poisons, fire safety, street crossing, sidewalk safety, railroad crossings, traffic signs/signals, bus safety, strangers, seat belts, car safety, playground safety, bike safety, personal identification, and the helping role of police personnel.

We want to help our children develop good safety habits which will guide them in making safe and responsible decisions throughout their lives. Children are required to attend every day for the 10 day program.
